









Shelf/Slope Bathymetry - NW Gulf of Mexico



Salt Dome Region








Typical seismic line through a Galveston Area salt dome

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




- **♦**Perched atop salt domes
- ♦ Northernmost coral reefs in the continental United States
- ◆ Reef foundation formed by large, stony corals (e.g. brain and star corals)
- ♦ About 23 coral species
- **♦** Over 850 other reef invertebrate species
- → ~250 fish species
- ♦ 125+ algae species






Long-term region-wide declines in Caribbean Corals




Average hard coral cover reduced by 80% (from 50% to 10%) in 30 years






NW Gulf of Mexico - High resolution multibeam surveys (1997 - 2005)








NW Gulf of Mexico - MMS No-Activity Zones (1974)








NW Gulf of Mexico - HAPC boundary recommendations (2005)








Flower Garden Banks Region - MMS No-Activity Zones (1974)








Flower Garden Banks Region - FGBNMS Sanctuary boundaries (1992)








Flower Garden Banks Region - USGS/NOAA/MMS surveys (1997-2005)

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















McGrail Bank - Multibeam Bathymetry 2002








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












Alderdice Bank - Multibeam Bathymetry 2002






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













Sonnier Bank - Multibeam Bathymetry 2002










Sonnier Bank - Millepora / Sponge Habitat






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





















