

Congressional "add-ons" used to forward fund & maintain contract staff capabilities in FY04-FY06

- Loss of "add on" in FY05 compensated for by FY04 extended funding of contracts
- Orderly reduction in FY06 negated by appropriation nearly 50% below President's request
