How the Charge Was Developed

 Departments of Commerce and the Interior identified key needs for national system implementation

NOAA

- Ideas discussed at meeting of NOAA Administrator and MPA FAC Chair (July 2007)
- Ideas presented to MPA FAC for input (Oct 2007)
- Final charge includes ideas from both agencies and MPA FAC







Short-Term (April 2008)

- Enforcement and compliance are critical to the success of individual MPAs and the National System
- Viewed as a high priority by the MPA FAC

• What are common principles and guidelines for fostering compliance within the national system?

- How can IOOS help address MPA management needs at the national and regional levels?










Longer-Term (2008-2009)

Management and Design of the National System to Support Resilient Marine Ecosystems and Communities

Key questions:

- How should the National System be designed and managed to build in resilience to anthropogenic impacts and naturally occurring processes?
- How can the National System contribute to community resilience?





Longer-Term (2008-2009)

• The Revised Draft Framework calls for guidelines for evaluating the National System. Recommend concepts that should be addressed in this evaluation.

Key questions:

- What types of issues should be addressed through this evaluation process?
- What types of approaches or performance measures should be considered?
- How will evaluating the National System differ from evaluations of individual MPAs?
