FY2008 Federal NOAA Appropriations for "Marine Protected Areas"

• FY2008 Federal Appropriation = \$1.484M

FY2009 Federal NOAA MPA Appropriations – To Be Determined


- President's Request & Senate Mark = \$2.128M (+ \$644K)
- House Mark = \$2,900M (+ \$1.416K)
- Continuing Resolution @ FY08 Level (to early March 2009) = \$1.484M

FY2009 External Funding

- CA Ocean Uses Atlas Project (FY08-09): Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation (\$555K) and Resources Legacy Fund Foundation (\$100K) support project-related MPA Center staff and other costs, some MPA Center in-kind support
- North American MPA Network (FY09 proposed) for North American MPA Network projects, some MPA Center in-kind support


Next Steps
