MPAs and CMSP



As complementary place-based approaches to ecosystem-based management, MPAs and CMSP have many opportunities for beneficial interactions:

- MPAs Contributing to CMSP: Providing relevant data, tools, stakeholders and expertise
- MPAs Benefitting from CMSP: Using local and regional planning processes and products to inform MPA designation and adaptive management
- Symmetrical Benefits: Setting regional objectives that reflect conservation and multiple use/access priorities

MPA-FAC recommendations will help shape and inform the NOC's:

- Strategic Action Plan / Implementation Plan
- CMSP Handbook
- National data portal services (aka NIMS)



How They Apply: Regional Planning Efforts



- MPA-FAC recommendations will provide guidance to Regional Planning Bodies in:
 - Engaging the full range of interested stakeholders
 - Setting regional objectives including conservation and multiple use
 - Assessing current and emerging ecosystem issues and trends
 - Evaluating the implications of tradeoffs among alternative ocean use scenarios
 - Monitoring the effectiveness of CMS plans and adaptively managing them as needed
 - Incorporating MPAs as a tool for place-based management within the wider CMSP mosaic



How They Apply: Emerging NOAA Priorities



- MPA-FAC recommendations will help guide NOAA's execution of the NOP and CMSP:
 - Integrate of data, maps, analytical models and products for planning
 - Support regional partnerships for comprehensive planning
 - Develop innovative visualization and decision support tools for ocean use planning
 - Contribute best available science for EBM decisions
